4Heros LLC has been officially licensed by the Department of the Air Force since 2016 and offers challenge coins, earrings, necklaces and pins that feature the Air Force Symbol, word marks and emblem, the Space Force Delta and words marks and the Air Force Thunderbirds.

Enkore Sign has been officially licensed by the Department of the Air Force since 2019 and offers bottle openers, home signs and retirement signs that feature the Air Force Symbol, word marks and emblem, the Space Force Delta and words marks and the Air Force Thunderbirds.
